Constitution of the Florida Atlantic University Debate Team
Article VII: Meetings

115 Article VII. Meetings

116 A. Meetings of the Executive Board shall take place in a manner they themselves may
117 provide, and may be called for by any member thereof. A quorum of the Board must be present for such
118 a meeting to be official.

119 B. Team meetings shall be held weekly throughout the fall and spring semesters on a day
120 and time and at a location to be decided on by a vote of the Executive Board at the beginning of each
121 semester, after they have received input from the active team membership. A quorum must be present
122 for such a meeting to be official.

123 C. Emergency meetings may be called for at any time by the Faculty Advisor, any/all
124 Assistant Advisor(s), the President, or the Vice President, so long as the Secretary provides notice to all
125 members of such a meeting. A quorum must be present for such a meeting to be made official.

126 D. As used in this Constitution, a "quorum" shall be defined as a simple majority of active
127 members. A "quorum of the Board" shall be defined as a simple majority of the Executive Board. A
128 "quorum of event members" shall be defined as a simple majority of the event in question.

129 E. As used in this constitution, a "simple majority" shall constitute fifty percent (50%) of
130 the members present and able to vote, plus one member.

131 F. As part of their official duties as described above, the Secretary shall notify members of
132 all meetings to which they may attend.
