Article VIII: Vacancies in Office

133 Article VIII. Vacancies in Office

134 A. In the event that the Presidency becomes vacant, either by resignation or impeachment,
135 the Vice President shall assume the Presidency and all responsibilities therein. The Vice President shall
136 then hold a special election to fill the now vacant Vice Presidency.

137 B. In the event that an office other than the Presidency becomes vacant, either by
138 resignation or impeachment, the President shall hold a special election to fill that office.

139 C. In the event that the President becomes temporarily unable to fulfill the duties of their
140 office for an extended period of time, indicated either by a letter transmitted to the Executive Board in
141 full, or by a Vote of No Confidence passed by two-thirds of the Executive Board, then the President shall
142 be temporarily relieved of their duties, and the Vice President shall assume the Acting Presidency, and
143 all duties and responsibilities therein. The Vice Presidency shall not be considered vacant during the
144 course of the Vice President's term as Acting President.

145 D. When the President once again becomes able to fulfill the duties of their office,
146 indicated either by letter transmitted to the Executive Board in full, or a Vote of Confidence passed by
147 two-thirds of the Executive Board (whichever method originally removed the President), the President
148 may reassume the Presidency, and all duties and responsibilities therein.
