**Constitution of the Florida Atlantic University Debate Team**  
**Article X: Bylaws**

181           Article X.       Bylaws

182           A.        “Bylaws” shall be defined as legislative articles that create offices or committees, or take  
183 any other action that aids the operation of FAU Debate, but do NOT alter this Constitution.

184           B.        Bylaws may be proposed by any member of the Executive Board, and shall take  
185 immediate effect if a simple majority of the Executive Board consents. At any time, the Executive Board  
186 may repeal bylaws by a simple majority vote.

187           C.        The Constitution, along with all laws to which it is bound, as is described above, shall  
188 supersede bylaws in the order of precedence and significance.

189           D.        The Secretary, in accordance with their duties as is described above, shall be responsible  
190 for furnishing the Office of Student Life & Recreation with any bylaws enacted by the Executive Board.
